

Why now?

Many areas across UC San Diego have successfully developed innovative solutions that reach different groups of Tritons

- Our experiences during the pandemic with Return-to-Learn have demonstrated the power of concerted action to amplify the effect of individual efforts
- External reviews have also identified greater collaboration as a significant opportunity for improvement
- Gov. Newsom's budget proposal provides five years of annual funding increases with a major caveat - universities must demonstrate progress closing opportunity gaps

Adopting a Collective Approach

For comprehensive solutions to the complex issues facing our university community, we must:

- Create connections between partners, initiatives, and programs
- Combine our expertise
- Leverage our collective efforts

Timeline/Phases

Assess Readiness 1 month	Conduct a readiness and landscape assessment
Initiate Action 2 months	 Kick off steering committee Begin outreach to potential partners Develop baseline landscape and data maps
Organize for Impact 3 months	 Create common agenda: clear problem definition, shared vision, basic theory of change Develop high-level overarching goal as well as leading metrics
Implementation 6 months	 Determine shared measurement systems and aligned strategies Establish mutually reinforcing activities Convene working groups
Sustain Action and Impact Ongoing	 Implement action plans and data collection Evaluate impacts, identify wins, refine strategies Evolve steering committee and working groups to match adaptive strategies

A collaborative approach to tackling complex challenges - a framework for leveraging complementary efforts to advance individual actions and achieve transformative change


Isolated vs. Collective Impact

Tackling complex challenges involves addressing their multiple causes and interdependent solutions; the power of collective impact stems from the collaboration of complementary activities as part of an overarching plan.

Five key conditions

Shared vision for change, including a common Common agenda understanding of the problem and a joint approach to solving it Collecting data and monitoring outcomes consistently Shared measurement supports alignment across activities Mutually reinforcing Stakeholders coordinate efforts through a mutually activities reinforcing plan of action. Structured and open communication is critical to Continuous building partnerships, supporting mutual objectives, and communication advancing strategic action Administrative support to guide the strategic plan, Backbone support organize partner actions, facilitate communication and

shared measurement systems, etc.

Action Network

Developing a network infrastructure provides opportunities for partners to connect and engage, building capacity for greater efficiency and impact

Cross-sector partnerships targeting a particular element of the common agenda




Steering committee

Provides strategic oversight and plays an important role bringing key stakeholders into the network



Backbone support

Fulfills the roles of facilitator, project manager, and data manager for the overarching collective impact initiative.



Collaborative links form across the network, forging new connections among workgroups and partners, as well as administrative support services or resources

Getting Started

Steps individual units can use to effectively collaborate with new partners and develop plans for transformative impact

>>> Plug into network

- Join existing efforts to partner, rather than work in silos
- Reaching across boundaries to engage university partners – innovation comes from seeing a system from different points of view
- Grow capabilities of the entire network

>> Build Action Plans

- Description of the problem informed by research and data
- A clear goal for desired change
- Portfolio of key strategies that will advance large-scale change
- Approach to evaluation and assessment

>> Convene Working Groups

 Groups lead execution of their particular strategies, identifying resources needed, coordinating activities among working group members and relevant partners, and monitoring data to measure progress.

>> Sustain Action & Impact

- Test strategies, develop action plans, implement best practices
- Monitor and improve; measure progress, reflect on results, apply learning to future efforts and continuously refine strategies
- Scale and spread success; make aligned action commitments, champion effective strategies across units, develop new collaborative partnerships
